

Acknowledgement of Country

We acknowledge our Elders Don, Chummy, and Glenys Collard and their moort (family) who have Welcomed us onto this land for a decade, since we first gathered here as Blazers in 2014. We pay our respects to the family, considering the passing of Don Collard in 2023. We lost a King and a leader, but he continues to walk beside his moort and keeps their wirin (spirit) strong. We acknowledge the Traditional Custodians of the Country we meet on, the Njaki Njaki, Ballardong, and Wiilman Nyoongar peoples. We acknowledge and respect their continuing culture and the contribution Nyoongar peoples make to the life of this region, and the balance and harmony they have maintained for 60,000 years.

When Nyoongar Country was invaded and colonisation began
194 years ago, Nyoongar peoples welcomed the settlers, showed them
the waterholes, and tried to teach them how to live harmoniously on
Country. We acknowledge the frontier wars, the intergenerational trauma,
the 558 deaths in custody, and the grief and loss that continues today as a
result of colonisation. This is still Nyoongar Country, sovereignty was never
ceded. Nyoongar stories are woven in the landscape, and Nyoongar language
gave the names 'Jilakin' and 'Kulin' to the lake
and the town we travel to.

Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples are the first peoples of Australia and the enduring custodians of the oldest living culture on earth. We recognise the strength, creativity, and resilience of all Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples and communities, and we celebrate the rich ways of knowing, being, and doing across Australia. Finally, we acknowledge our allies, who walk with us towards social justice, in a movement of the Australian people for a better future and a fuller expression of Australia's nationhood.

Always was, always will be Aboriginal land.



Each year we gather at the Bush Racetrack beside Jilakin Lake on farmland made available to us by the Lucchesi family, who came here generations ago, and we also thank them for hosting us here. We drive through Kulin, the township and people who have supported us for a decade, who built the roads and the facilities we see around us. We thank them for their continued support.

At our event, we share with the local peoples the great privilege of watching the moon and sun rise over these billion-year-old rocks, beside the remnants of a river that flowed south past here 130 million years ago, when the land now known as Australia was joined to Antarctica.

We acknowledge that this is old Country that was here long before us and will be here long after us. The Blazing Swan principle of Radical Inclusion invites us to "welcome the stranger." This transformative philosophy is central to our event and our community. When we reflect on what this means, we can understand that in this Country, we are the strangers who have been welcomed. When we then welcome the stranger that we meet at our event, we are passing on a gift that has been given to us and our ancestors, and we are sharing a special place that has been shared with us.

The Welcome To Country Ceremony will be held from 11am to 12:30 pm on Saturday, 30 March, at the Effigy.

The Jilakin Rock City Rangers

The Jilakin Rock Rangers are participants just like you, who volunteer their sober time at Blazing Swan to serve the safety and wellbeing of the Blazing Swan community.



Rangers act as non-confrontational

Community Mediators and provide reliable information & public safety. They work in unison with emergency services and the production crew to help mediate disagreements, find lost kids, address safety concerns, direct participants to resources, or just add a fresh set of eyes to a tricky situation.

You can identify Rangers by their khaki shirts & wide brimmed hats with the Ranger logo, along with their tell-tale radios, ID lanyards & that they always walk in pairs. After dark they are easily spotted from afar with their bright LED bandoliers worn diagonally across the body.

If you find yourself in need of a Ranger, stop by Ranger HQ, their headquarters on the corner of Halcyon and Poppie Streets, identified by the Ranger flags and banners. There's a toasty burn barrel just outside to sit and have a yarn, ask a question or simply warm up on a chilly night.

Green Dot Rangers: the other kind of Ranger... Green Dot Rangers assist with situations involving participants who are in unusual states of mind: grief, disorientation, fear, confusion, or sensory overload, along with a wide range of related states fuelled by the sometimes intense & challenging nature of Blazing Swan. Green Dots, in conjunction with Medical, operate the Sanctuary space: a low-sensory environment for participants having an intense experience who are in need of a safe, monitored space. You can request Green Dot assistance via any Ranger, just flag one down and ask for help.

Let's Burn! Rangers will be seen *en masse* forming the Perimeter during the Effigy and Temple Burns. Please follow their instructions as they are here to help ensure everyone's safety, and they will help you get the best out of your burn!

Photography

The number one issue to be aware of when taking photos or video of people at Blazing Swan is the Principle of Consent. Not everyone wants their image captured, or not at certain times; it's important to ask their permission before taking their photo.

Consent is a clear verbal confirmation of "yes" in response to a request for permission. A response of "no" means no, and so does "maybe" or a shrug. There may be times when it's best to capture someone "in the moment," but in this case you should introduce yourself afterwards, show them the image and ask for their consent. If they request the photo be deleted, do so immediately and respect their decision.

Community Photographers: you can spot one of our pre-registered community photographers by their ID lanyard and unique number. Get in contact with them directly via the details below.

If you have a concern or question with a photographer or consent, politely let them know. If there's still an issue, tell a Ranger or the Event Team so it can be resolved. If it's a major concern, you can contact Blazing Swan: https://blazingswan.com.au/contact-us/

Only pre-approved drones are allowed on site. Feel free to report any drones you may see to the Rangers or Event Managers.

The Magical Frontier (TMF) — We are a Western style theme camp with a big emphasis on soulful music in a relaxed environment...... At 10pm each night we feed our patrons with toasted sandwiches that are made on our one of a kind toastie station!!

The Poolroom (TPR) – The Poolroom is an on-street walk-in bar and lounge, gifting drinks, hosting events and more. Drop in for a drink, chat and a laugh with the friendly Poolroom crew. The Poolroom... where too much serenity is never enough.

Blazing Swan has changed my life! The Effigy and the Temple

The Effigy and the Temple, Blazing Swan's two largest structures and biggest art burns, each have a unique purpose at the event, and their burns are distinctly different.

The Effigy is an artistic structure that brings together our Blaze community in unified celebration. Each year the structure is different in design, corresponding to the event theme and usually featuring a swan. The Effigy Burn is on Saturday, just after sunset. At this time, we gather as a community in celebration, building energy through the fire and drum performance of the Fire Conclave, before releasing the Effigy in pyrotechnic delight. Be sure to arrive well before the scheduled time, to get your spot along the burn perimeter for a great view. Please be aware that the dominant wind direction carries ash and smoke towards Cave Rock and to the northwest, which is not an advisable viewing location.

The Temple is an artistic structure that serves as our community's sacred space. It is a space of quiet reflection, contemplation, and connection. The structure is interactive, with many choosing to write messages on its walls, add photos, and leave mementos that express their thoughts, feelings, and reflections. The structure is open until noon on Sunday morning, after which it is closed to prepare for the Burn. While approaching and visiting this beautiful space, please be respectful and remain quiet. The Temple Burn is at sunset on Sunday. As we gather to watch the burn, we honour the powerful emotions the Temple holds through our collective silence. We respect this sacred space, and in silence watch all that it holds released to the heavens.

Please Note: for all art burns at Blazing Swan, you must stay behind the marked burn perimeter. This is vital to ensuring a safe burn and the future of Blazing Swan. Please respect our Ranger and Sentinel volunteers, follow their instructions, and assist fellow Blazers in doing the same. Thank you.

I think the success of the burn nights is probably the biggest achievement for me. It's when everyone involved gets to let out a sigh of relief and breathe easier, that it all came together and then burned to the ground with the same success. The emotion attached to this is sometimes overwhelming but in the best possible way.

1 The Effigy

Temple Design: Neesh Peacock

Welcome to the Temple of Triscendence. This year as you approach the Temple you will notice that the space extends further than the walls of the main structure. We created this quieter space around the Temple to keep external sounds dull and distant within the Temple walls. As you cross into the Temple, please be mindful of your fellow Blazers and the space they are holding.

Temple of Triscendence unites three parts, representing how we interact with ourselves, each other and the environment. As we contemplate and reflect on these relationships, a deep understanding of our subconscious, conscious and higher selves emerges providing access to a lifetime of learning, relearning and growth.

Our subconscious selves hold all that we learned to survive from a young age. Much of this was bestowed by our ancestors and caregivers. Although useful when we were small and powerless, these parts can persist, and there may be struggle between letting the familiar guide us and trying to unlearn lessons we were taught. When we do not question these teachings, these parts remain predominant, but can become less driving as we learn to study and reflect the undesired actions and impacts. The smaller it becomes, the more malleable it becomes towards new instincts that allow us to connect and love safely, to express our unique creativity, and to positively influence the world.

As we enter new realms, we become aware of our higher selves, a self that understands what our heart desires and where we want to be. This contains our deepest drives and the dreams that constantly push us toward the life we envision. Discomfort may become louder when we work against this. We may find ourselves feeling sad or angry when our journey is not on the right path. This is our best self, striving to be met halfway on a journey that can be uncomfortable and painful but ultimately lights the way forward to a life of truth, peace and love.

Finally, we arrive at the present: our conscious self. No past stories or guaranteed future but a constant regeneration minute by minute. As we let go of stories of the past, the present becomes larger and allows us grounding. With the expansion we can experience pain in unknowingness, much as fire and smoke lead to destruction of the familiar. That which has been destroyed is replaced with rejuvenation, abundance and beauty.

These three structures are separate yet connected as are the different stages of our lives. Each is more visible than we may realize, rising from our actions and interactions. We know time in nature calms us, brings us back to our true selves, and grounds us. This year the altar helps bring us back to nature, carrying with it an abundance of possibilities for growth. It shows beauty in the things that were once alive but now pass on the seeds for new life to begin.

You are encouraged to participate in a symbolic act of catharsis, shed what is obsolete, and embrace the power of renewal. As we burn the Temple, we hope that you let the burdens of the past dissolve into the fire, allowing deeper connection to expression, understanding, and self-acceptance.

Please be mindful that the Temple will close to participants at noon on Sunday to allow for the burn preparation. This closure is observed for the safety of everyone on site and the crew preparing for the burn. We encourage people to visit the Temple throughout the week to engage and take time within the space.

MOOP

Our principle of Leaving No Trace! MOOP (Matter Out Of Place) is exactly that, anything that doesn't belong where it is. This includes everything that was not at Jilakin Rock City before we arrived, such as regular ole' garbage, feathers that fell off your very pretty outfit, or even those rocks you moved to chock your car. Everyone unintentionally MOOPs sometimes, whether you've forgotten where you left your tasty beverage or accidentally knocked over a pan of tasty bacon. So we try to work together as a community to pick up all of our MOOP; someone will

definitely dispose of your can for you, so try to do the same if you see any MOOP on the playa. Leave (nothing!) No Trace

Pro tips for MOOP

- Carry around a little ziplock bag or bottle to hold stray MOOP you find
- Do a daily MOOP sweep of your campsite, or hey, even the whole site!
- Smokers can bring or make portable ashtrays: mint tins or film canisters make great butt receptacles
- Be aware of things you're doing that might create MOOP: cutting the ends off zip ties, crafting, doing the washing-up...
- Think ahead when packing for Blaze (& leave your MOOP-y things at home): no one wants to clean up an exploded bean bag, every feather from a blown-away boa, or tiny foil bits from a thousand Easter eggs.
 You can also take MOOP off your things before you arrive: stickers, plastic wrapping, excess packaging etc.
- DO NOT EVER use a private rubbish bin or dumpster to dispose of your waste, either at the event or in Kulin. The lovely folks in town are very supportive of our event & don't need Blazers filling up their rubbish tips.
- Do a thorough MOOP sweep after you pack up & before you leave.
 Everyone walk over every inch of your camp, looking for anything that shouldn't be there. This includes items that aren't yours or have clearly been there for a while.

Kulin volunteers are running a donation-based rubbish collection at the event exit on Tuesday. Please donate generously to avoid driving home with your stinky bags of rubbish (2)



Consent extends not only to people's bodies, but also their belongings & art

An impaired individual can't give consent. Keep it cool and seek sobriety before getting sexy

Don't make assumptions about consent. If you don't know - ask

Consent is FREELY given without guilt or pressure
