Prepare for the worst, expect the best!

Top Tips:

Regularly check weather forecasts but understand that it may not always be accurate due to our location. A weather station is set up at Ranger HQ to record and monitor onsite weather.

Prepare for all weather.

Bring extra ties, duct tape tent pegs, guy ropes etc.

Peg and tie down your tent/gazebo etc.

Bring waterproof clothing.

Have a waterproof tent (yes we wrote that).
