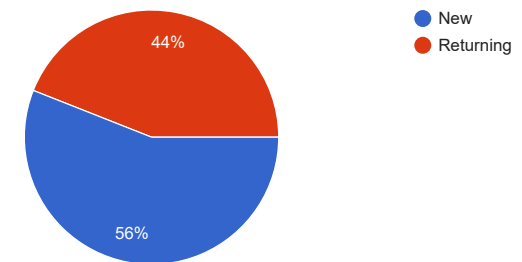

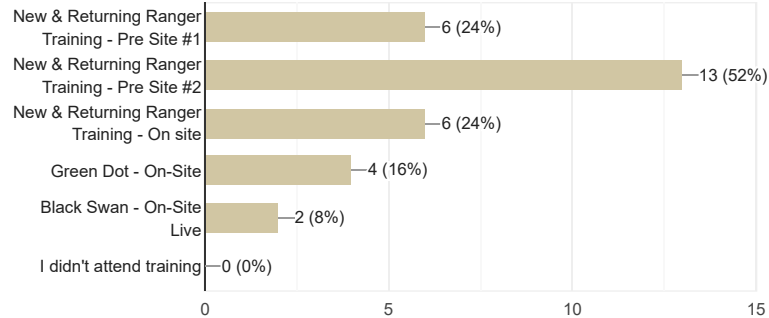

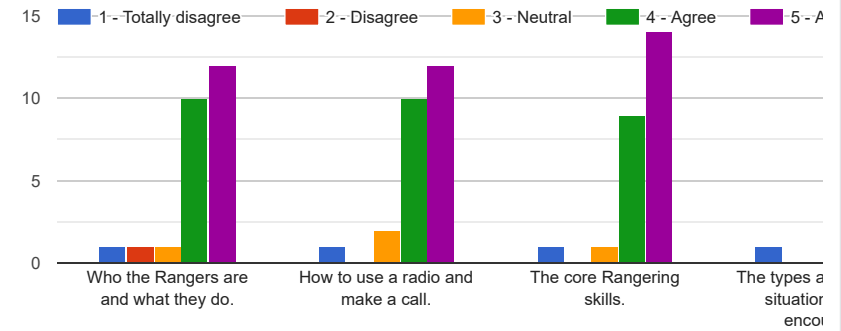

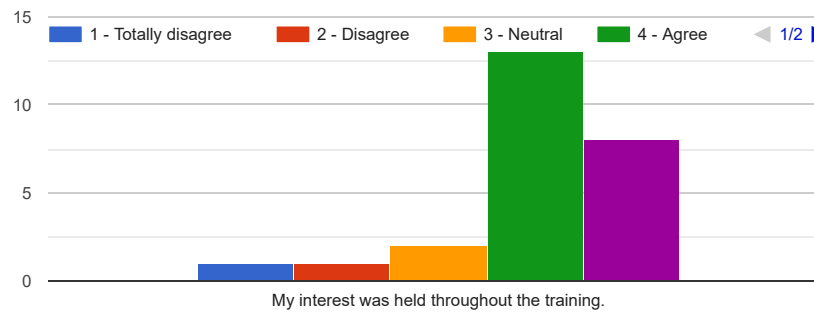

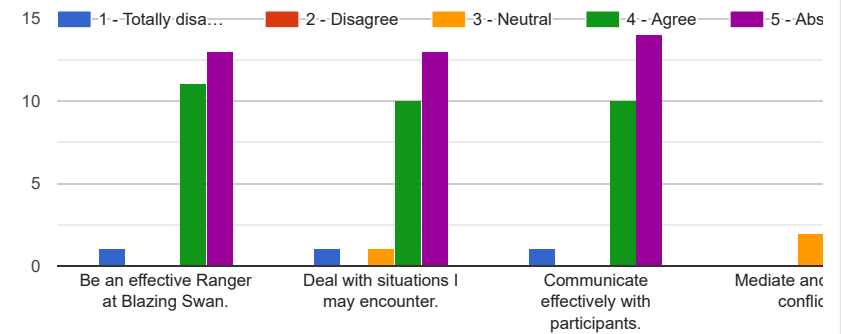

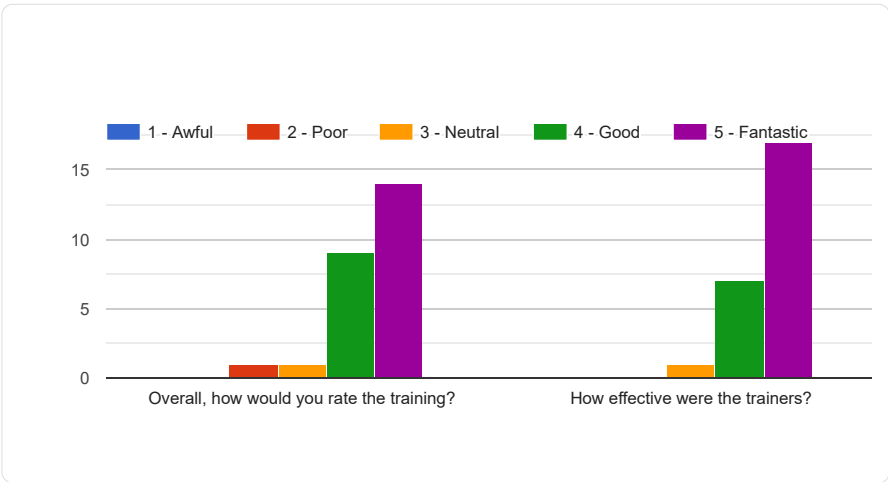


### The training provided me with information on how to:
